Important Notification

EDIUS 9 requires SHA-2 hash algorithm code signing to be active Grass Valley hardware driver. All versions of Windows 7, Windows 8.1 and Windows 10 already support SHA-2 code signing, but if you are running Windows 7, you will need to install Security Updates.

SHA-2 code signing requires installation of Windows 7 updates in order to use Grass Valley hardware. There are following two ways to support SHA-2 code signing:

Obtain the latest update (recommended)

Obtain the latest update from Windows Update

Install two security updates

- 1. Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-Based Systems (KB3035131)
- 2. Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-Based Systems (KB3033929)

If they have not been installed, installed Grass Valley hardware may not work.

Update History

The following issues are fixed or improved in this version:



EDIUS

- EDIUS freezes when closing Stabilizer's setup dialog after In/Out rendering
- Nest sequence has incorrect TC (SFDC00703120)
- Audio playback of a certain mov file (SFDC00710416)
- Exported AAF has wrong audio
- EDIUS freezes if effect is disabled/enabled while VAR playback (SFDC00709309)
- EDIUS creates MPEG2 MXF clips unable to be played in 3rd party player (SFDC00708668)
- Y curve unexpectedly changes when re-opening Primary Color Correction (SFDC00711441)
- Roll Title can't be edited
- Source timecode burned-in to an exported file is affected by output timecode setting (SFDC00700929)
- Unnecessary key frames appear in Color balance effect (SFDC00712530)
- Warning message appears Incorrectly when syncing clip which has no audio
- GV License Manager fails to create ID files for offline activation if the target is the root directory
- When you change the selection of exporter, combo-box of closed caption type has been flickering
- EDIUS crashes when rendering certain video clip
- Videoscope crashes when mount clip to Player whose width is not video standard

Mync

- Thumbnail view type changes when deleting a storyboard
- FCP xml exported by Mync loses information about linked video and audio
- Storyboard preview shows red checkerboard pattern on the end of sequence
- Clip count does not tally between Explorer Panel and View Browser when create storyboard using unregistered clip

Restrictions after Uninstallation of QuickTime for Windows

The following functionality will be lost if QuickTime is uninstalled:

- Still Image File Formats: Flash Pix; Mac Pict; QuickTime Image
- MOV Video File Formats: M4V or some MOV file formats
- MOV Video File Formats: 3GP; 3G2 (export)
- Audio File Formats: MOV (other than Linear PCM and AAC); QuickTime Audio
